**Facilities:** **The Ferny CoombePool** is an outdoor pool that is 25 meters in length with 6 swimming lanes.

The local **Lions's Club** will again be operating the concession. No other concession sales are allowed without prior written approval from the Agassiz-Harrison Aquanauts.

**Camping** is available in **DESIGNATED AREAS WITH A \$10.00 FEE. \$20 for those hooked up to power.** This year the district has ruled that there will be tenting only allowed in the space beside the tennis courts and the Agricultural Hall. All trailers and vehicles must park on the parking lot/ access roadways. Areas will be marked and we will have a parent available to help with designating camping areas. Washrooms in the Agricultural Hall will be open during the day, and the Fitness Centre nearby has showers available for a fee. Washrooms in the Livestock Pavilion will be open 24 hours a day.

All participants are reminded that the Agassiz Recreational Fairgrounds is a public facility and the consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited. Open flame camp fires are not allowed on the Fairgrounds.

**NOTE:** The PA system will not operate until 8:00 am as a courtesy to the neighbouring residents. Marshalling will begin at approx. 8:00 am. ***Please inform your swimmers at warm-ups so that they are aware and proceed to marshalling by 7:45 am for the first events.***

**Meet Objective:** To have fun while encouraging participation and consistent personal accomplishment in the sport of competitive swimming.

**Events:** Each competitor may enter 6 individual events and 2 relays

**Meet Entries:**

Deadline for entries is June 7th 8:00 pm. All clubs please include a contact person and phone number. Please use the meet entry file provided on the website.

Out of region clubs will be entered at a cost of \$5.00 per event and \$7.00 per relay.

**Entry Fees:**

Deck Entries will be accepted at the **discretion of the Clerk of the Course** at \$5.00 per event. We will not create new heats. Early scratches and late changes will be accepted by June 8<sup>th</sup> at midnight by email to Anne at [staiger@telus.net](mailto:staiger@telus.net)

**“O” Category Swimmers:**

“O” category swimmers will compete in “O” Cat events. There will be “O” Cat relays in the meet package, or the division 8 relays are open events to all swimmers. One “O” Cat swimmer may swim per each divisional relay and must be clearly identified in the entries. One divisional swimmer may swim in an “O” Cat relay.

If there are too few “O” Cat swimmers in an event they may be collapsed into their division. **This is at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course** and depending on the number of free lanes in the appropriate division.

**Scratches/Deck Entries:**

Please have deck entries/scratches handed in to the Clerk of the Course by 7:30 am each day and relays in by 10:00 am each morning. Cards will NOT be accepted after those times. Depending on time and volume limits acceptance of any deck entries is at the **sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course.** We will not re-seed events to accommodate late entries; they will be placed in available spaces and slow heats. Deck entries must be on cards. Events will be collapsed if possible.

**Rules:**

All BCSSA rules will apply along with the following:

- All events will be swum as Time-Finals.
- No DQ's for 6 & under events, 6 & U events are not official events and are not scored.
- 6 & under swimmers start in shallow end in the water NO DIVING.
- False start rule is in effect. Should a false start occur, the race will continue and the swimmer will be disqualified at the end of the race.
- Relay teams may use swimmers from lower divisions as long as one team member is from the entered division.
- “O” cat swimmers will be entered in to the appropriate event (see “O” Category). Division 8 relays are an open event.
- If the timing system fails to start, the heat will have to be swum again per the rule of a re-swim.

- No place judging will occur. All placements will be the result of the times calculated as either an official electronic time or by the calculation of the official manual time if electronic time is determined to be invalid.

**NOTE:** Marshalling will not be required for Divisions 5 and up. Swimmers will be responsible for reporting to their events.

**Points:** Scoring for all individual events will be: 14, 12, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1; relay events will be: 14, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2. There will be no points or place ribbons awarded to swimmers in the 6 & under events. Instead they'll receive goodie bags and participation ribbons and their time will be posted.

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded to the first 12 places for each individual swim. As well as for each relay. Individual aggregate winners and runner-ups will be given keeper awards. Depending on their numbers, division 7 and 8 may be combined as a single event. We will distribute the ribbons/medals at the conclusion of the meet. We would like a coach/representative from each team to report to the swim club office to pick them up.

**Officials:** Volunteers are required from all clubs. Sign-up sheet will be posted and should be completed prior to 7:30 am.  
Each club is required to supply:

- Timers and Recorders as per lane assignments (TBA)
- Stroke and Turn and Senior officials

We encourage all new parents to shadow our officials.
