## AHA Swim Club 2011 Season - Fee Schedule

### **6 and Under, and Development Swimmers:**

*based on ability*

*see website for development description*

12 weeks - May 2 to July 22, 2011  
3 days per week, 45 minute lessons  
4 to 4:45 PM or 5 to 5:45 PM

\$150 for the full session or \$50 per month  
( \$50 May or \$50 June or \$50 July)

### **Division 1 to 3 Swimmers:**

*typically ages 7-10, birth date dependant*

15 weeks - May 2 to August 12, 2011  
3 or 5 days per week, 1 hour lessons  
4 to 6 PM  
(4 to 5 PM for younger swimmers)  
(5 to 6 PM for older swimmers)  
(schedule changes after July 22)

\$250 for 5 days/week (full session)  
\$180 for 3 days/week (part time session)  
or \$60 per month (part time session)

### **Division 4 to 8 Swimmers:**

*typically 10+, birth date dependant*

15 weeks - May 2 to August 12, 2011  
5 to 6 PM (Mon Wed Fri)  
5 to 6:30 PM (Tues Thurs)  
(schedule changes after July 22)

\$300 for 5 days/week (full session)  
\$240 for 3 days/week (part time session)  
or \$80 per month (part time session)

### **Adult Swimmers:**

*typically the parents and,*

*birth date is a non-issue - we're all friends here*

15 weeks—May 2 to August 12, 2011  
\$150 for three days per week  
\$200 for five days per week

### **Water Polo Wednesdays:**

ages 8 and up

free to all registered swimmers

6 weeks - June 1 to July 6, 6 to 7 PM

### **Anti-Fundraising Fee:**

All swimmers pay \$50 per family per year.

### **Multi-Swimmer Discount:**

Third and fourth child deduct \$25 off the full fees or \$15 off the part time fees.

### **Early Bird Discounts:**

If registering before April 15, 2011, a \$25 early bird discount applies off full session fees, and \$15 early bird discount off part time fees. No discounts apply to one-month-at-a-time fees.
